



The right way to chisel

Procedure:

Chiselling like a master craftsman

Expert DIYers also have a few tricks up their sleeve for simple work like chiselling. We will tell you what they are.

- 1** Important: Please always wear protective glasses when chiselling because splintering parts can easily get into your eyes.
- 2** Pilot chiselling: First of all, you have to strike a guide groove. To do this, hold the chisel at a slight angle and make the guide groove approximately one centimetre deep by means of light hammer blows. This scores the material.
- 3** Breakthrough chiselling: Now hold the chisel in an upright position and guide the hammer into the guide groove, in order to break off the workpieces.
- 4** Pay attention to the following when you clamp workpieces for chiselling: The chisel direction must always point against the vice jaws.
