



A quick guide to screws

Procedure:

Which is each different screw suitable for?

If you stand in front of the screw shelf at a DIY store, you will find a vast range of screws for every purpose. The various purposes can usually be assigned to the screws simply by the shape of the screw head.

- 1 Screws with a round head or fillister head are mainly used for securing fittings, signs and strips. Decoration screws are sometimes also used in furniture manufacture.
- 2 There are also screws with cylindrical heads and others with hexagonal heads for the socket of a screw wrench. They are used for fitting work in wooden beams.
- 3 have a round head with a square section under the head. It is intended to prevent the bolt from turning when the nut is tightened. This bolt can only be loosened from the nut side. Carriage bolts are mainly required for woodworking.
- 4 Always make sure that you use the appropriate screwdriver (or wrench) for your work. If you use the wrong one, it might be impossible to remove fitted screws, meaning that if the worst comes to the worst they will be ruined.
