### Dog bowl with style

Gone are the days when your dog had to bend down to eat, because now you can treat him to the chair feeding bowl!



## 1 Introduction

Who let the dogs out? Your canine companion will need no invitation to eat at this stylish feeding station. With a bit of DIY skill, you can easily integrate the feeding bowl into the chair yourself. Create a truly delicious designer piece, and give your four-legged friend a treat: Gone are the days when your dog had to bend down to eat.

### Required power tools:

- > Cordless multisaw

### Other accessories:

- > Pencil
- > Utility knife
- > Paintbrush

## 2 Sawing the holes



First measure the diameter of the feeding bowl underneath its rim, and then draw a circle of the same size in the centre of the seat of the chair. Then cut out the circle along the line. You will be able to saw a clean hole with the PST 10,8 LI cordless multisaw. Repeat the steps on the other chair.

### **3 Cutting out the decoration**

To ensure that a perfect dog's bone decorates the back of the chair later on, print out the template and cut it out. Transfer the outline of the bone onto the adhesive film using a pencil and cut it out along the outline.

### **4 Attaching the decoration**

Now attach the adhesive film to the desired position on the back of the chair.

### **5 Customising the feeding bowl**

Then colour in the affixed bone shape with the paintbrush and the blackboard paint. Important: Leave the paint to dry well so that there are no frayed edges afterwards! Then peel off the film and write whatever you want on the black surface, for example "Eat" and "Drink". Finally, place the dog bowl in the sawn hole, fill it with your dog's favourite food – and feeding time will become even more enjoyable.
